



DOES YOUR PATIENT QUALIFY FOR DIABETIC SHOES ?

Your patient may qualify for Diabetic Shoes and Inserts if your patient has Diabetes AND must have one the six qualifying foot conditions.

Those conditions are: (DIABETES RELATED)

- ❖ History of partial or complete amputation of the foot
- ❖ History of previous foot ulceration
- ❖ History of pre-ulcerative callus
- ❖ Peripheral Neuropathy with evidence of callus formation
- ❖ Foot Deformity due to Diabetes (bunions, hammer toes charcot foot etc)
- ❖ Poor Circulation (Diabetic PVD, Edema etc)

Diabetic care providers (MD's or DO's) should routinely require their diabetic patients to remove their socks and shoes to examine for dry skin, calluses, ulcers, foot deformities or decreased or diminished sensation.

Referral to a Podiatrist (DPM) is usually done when major issues are identified.

It is necessary to document the presence of any qualifying foot condition in the medical record of your patient since this information will allow CustomFit ProLabs to provide your patients with their yearly Diabetic footwear by meeting Medicare (And Medicare HMO) required standards.
